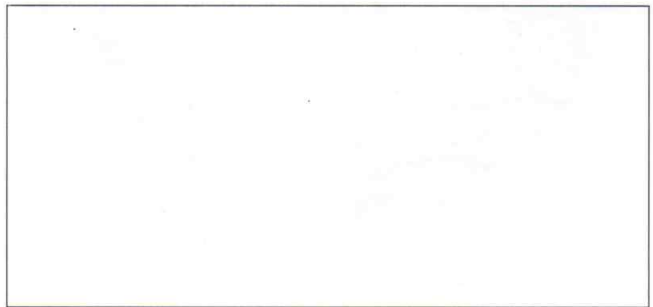

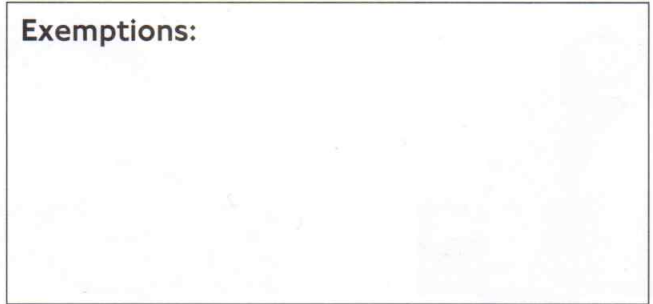

**Change of Address**

If you wish to change your address please call 0343 222 4444, where you will need to provide confirmation that you are the licensee, as well as details of your new address.

We will then issue you with an updated licence within **14 days** of you contacting us. You must return your old Licence to London Taxi and Private Hire. The driver Licence remains the property of TfL at all times.

**Please note the following important Information:**

- All private hire bookings must be made, in advance, through a licensed London private hire operator. PHV drivers cannot ply for hire as only licensed taxi's (black cabs) can legally do so.
- PHV drivers cannot approach and solicit passengers for hire as this will constitute touting, which is illegal. If you commit the offence of touting your licence may be revoked and you may also be prosecuted.
- Vehicles must be covered by hire and reward insurance at the point they are licensed and whenever it is used as a private hire vehicle. Details of the insurance must be carried by the driver or displayed in the vehicle.
- Private hire vehicles cannot enter or use bus lanes in restricted times unless for picking up and setting down in permitted areas. They also cannot automatically drop off and pick up on red routes.
- You cannot refuse to carry guide and/or assistance dogs without a specific medical exemption. If you do so, you are committing an offence for which you may be prosecuted and fined up to £1000.
- Private hire vehicles are not permitted to park, stop or wait on taxi ranks. Use of these ranks is for licensed taxis (black cabs) only.
- You must notify TfL of any changes to your licence or personal circumstances within 21 days. A list of your obligations can be found on the letter that was issued to you with your original licence.
